Catering for girls and boys in Years 5 and 6 from around Tasmania, the goal is to encourage passion and expertise in science inquiry.

Tasmanian students have a clearly defined pathway to promote scientific inquiry skills. Excellence in science is promoted through participation in the:

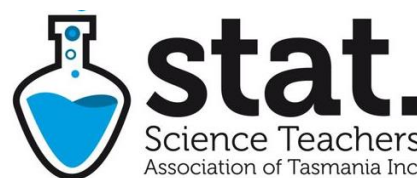
- *UTAS Science and Engineering Investigation Awards*
