Over one school term, students become part of the Scotch Oakburn College community. They attend classes, experience boarding life, build friendships, practise English every day and develop greater independence.

For many students, one term is the perfect first step. It is long enough to settle into a new routine, make friends and grow in confidence, while still being a manageable time away from home.

Why Tasmania?

Tasmania is a safe, welcoming and naturally beautiful place to study.

With clean air, open spaces, friendly communities and easy access to nature, Tasmania offers international students a calm and supportive environment for learning, wellbeing and personal growth.

In Launceston, students can experience Australian school life in a regional city that feels connected, safe and easy to settle into.

At Scotch Oakburn College, students experience more than an education. They experience Tasmania — a place to learn, belong and grow.

Why choose this program?

This program is ideal for students who are ready for a meaningful overseas experience, but may not yet want to commit to a longer stay.

Students are supported to take part in school life, try new activities and communicate in English in natural, everyday ways.

- Boarding life and supervised routines

Safety, care and wellbeing

Scotch Oakburn provides a structured and supportive environment where students are known and cared for. Students are supported by boarding staff, teachers, pastoral care staff and wellbeing structures across the College.

The College understands that students may feel nervous when they first arrive. They are helped to settle into routines, understand expectations, make connections and ask for support when needed.

A home away from home

Boarding is a key part of the Study Abroad experience.

Students share meals, study time, weekend activities and everyday life with other students. This helps them build friendships, practise English and feel part of the College community. Boarding provides structure, routine and care outside the classroom, helping students grow in confidence and independence.

Where accommodation is required during extended breaks, homestay may be considered in some circumstances, subject to availability, welfare requirements and approval.

English language

Students do not need advanced English to apply.

The most important qualities are a positive attitude, curiosity, effort and willingness to participate. Students are supported to build English confidence through daily school life, boarding routines and friendships.
