



STUDENT HAS COVID SYMPTOMS

- Do not attend school, stay home and use one of your supplied RATs.
- If a student develops symptoms during a school day, they should notify their teacher and attend Reception immediately. Reception will contact parents/carers and take care of the student until collected from the College. After leaving the College, please administer one of your supplied RATs.
- Advise the relevant Reception (listed below) of the status of the absence (COVID positive / negative / still symptomatic).
- **Do not return to school whilst symptomatic** – please continue to advise Reception daily during the student's absence.
- Remain at home until symptoms have gone.
- Once symptoms have gone and the student feels well – use a second supplied RAT to confirm that they are COVID-negative. Assuming this is the case, the student is then cleared to return to school. (In the event that they test positive, refer below.)
- On return to school, students obtain their replacement RATs from their relevant Reception (*if all RATs are used before the student returns to school a parent/carer can collect additional RATs from the relevant Reception*).



STUDENT TESTS POSITIVE

- Do not attend school.
- Advise the relevant Reception (listed below) of the absence and the date of the positive COVID test.
- Remain at home for seven (7) days AND until symptoms have gone.
- Once symptoms have gone and they are no longer under Public Health isolation, they can return to school.
- Students can obtain replacement RATs from the relevant Reception.



STUDENT IS A CLOSE CONTACT

- Use a supplied RAT to determine the student's covid status. If positive, see above for what to do if 'Student tests positive'.
- If COVID-negative and non-symptomatic, students can attend school. Daily testing is to occur for close contacts for seven (7) days.
- Students can attend school during this period if they are COVID-negative AND non-symptomatic.
- On return to school, obtain replacement RATs from the relevant Reception.
