The Science Experience in Hobart: Synthesise chemicals, learn about Tasmania's wildlife, solve engineering challenges, examine minerals and soils, help build a robot, hear about how computer games are used in research, see drones in action, visit the Medical Sciences Precinct and the Institute of Marine and Antarctic Studies – we have lots of activities on offer!

The Science Experience in Launceston: Experiment in the Chemistry laboratory to prepare aspirin and slime, test out your eyewitness memory in forensic psychology, learn about human physiology in the Exercise Science lab, try out the latest technologies in the Human Interface Technology Lab (HITLab), see marine science in action with the Institute of Marine & Antarctic Studies and go behind the scenes at the Australian Maritime College!
